Graduated *cum laude* in 1986 from the University of Milan, where he obtained his specialisation in Cardiology with full marks in 1991.

He first practised at the De Gasperis Cardiological Centre (Niguarda Hospital) from 1986 to 1993, initially on a fellowship and then as an assistant cardiologist.

During his post-graduate specialisation, he spent long training periods abroad (at the UCSD Medical Center in San Diego, the Cedars Sinai Medical Center in Los Angeles, Hôpital Cardio-

Vasculaire in Lyon and Hôpital Tenon in Paris), where he extended his clinical and research experience in the fields of cardiac (transthoracic and transesophageal) and vascular (transcranial, supra-aortic trunk, abdominal aorta and lower limb) colour Doppler ultrasonography.

Between 1993 and June 2005, he worked as an assistant cardiologist and then as a level I manager at the Cardiology Division of Ospedale Maggiore Policlinico di Milano IRCCS, where he continued his activities in the fields of diagnostic imaging (echocardiograhy, vascular colour Doppler ultrasonography, nuclear cardiology) and clinical cardiology (coronary care unit and cardiological A&E department). During this period, he taught echocardiography at the Post-graduate School of Geriatrics, and also acquired considerable experience in the diagnostic and therapeutic approach to patients with multi-district vascular disease.

From 1997 to 2011, he coordinated cardiovascular ultrasonography activities and acted as a consultant cardiologist for the Città di Milano private clinic.

He is co-author of more than 80 papers published in scientific journals.

Since June 2005, he has been the director of his own cardiological centre in Milan which, in addition to cardiological and electrocardiographic examinations, offers colour Doppler echocardiographic and cardiovascular, abdominal, thyroid and breast colour Doppler ultrasonographic examinations, as well as 24-hour blood pressure and 24-hour and weekly Holter monitoring.

He is currently a cardiological consultant for the La Madonnina and La Capitanio private clinics and, since 2005, has been a member of the Steering Committee of the Maria Letizia Verga Committee for the Study and Treatment of Infantile Leukemias, which supports the Pediatric Department at San Gerardo Hospital in Monza.
